

## CMSA Meeting Minutes – Tuesday, January 15, 2013

1. Meeting called to order 6:30pm
2. Minutes accepted as presented by Rob/Roger
3. Appears that we are getting nowhere with the changes that are proposed to KSYSA. All KSYSA members that are not from Castlegar (2 in Castlegar and 2 in Rossland, 2 in BV, 2 in Trail), are opposed to any BC Soccer representative joining any KSYSA meetings. They believe that CMSA representatives wish to bully all other towns in KSYSA.
4. Noone has stepped into the role as Fundraising Coordinator so we have no one to seek sponsorship for the upcoming season. Yuro will talk to Dave to see what needs to be done and if we can quickly find someone to take this role.
5. Leanne Ireland will check for a database and send registration requests to let all past players know that registration is open on a certain date. This date has not yet been communicated to CMSA. Yuro will do a "Letter from the President" and send it to Leanne so that she can add it to the email. Leanne has created a registration document for U4 who register at the complex. Yuro will put an ad in the Castlegar News. Leanne will ask the complex to advertise in their weekly events column in the paper. Leanne will send an electronic copy of the newsletter to all schools and printed copies to KE.
6. Mr. Clemente at KSYSA will be doing coach development for the area. Scott wants to wait to see what dates he picks before doing any coach development for CMSA. There are a few different levels that coaches can take through BC Soccer but he may leave this up to KSYSA and focus on SoccerQuest where we have a credit from the summer soccer camp. Camps will be the first 2 weeks of April as the season will begin roughly around April 15, 2013 and run for 11 weeks.
7. There are vacant positions on the executive. Fundraising Coordinator, Youth Boys Coordinator, and U4 Coordinator. We need to start asking around to see if anyone would be interested in filling these positions.
8. Discussion on team sizes and what we may be looking at for this season.

9. Roger Carlson would like to hold another jamboree this summer. There are grant funds available from BC Soccer. Roger will apply and send a report on last year's successful Jamboree. Date proposed in August sometime. This will be for U10-U11-U12 players.
10. Indoor Soccer payment to Selkirk College for January to April needed. The invoice was given to Yuro who will pass it on to Susanne.
