**1) Report on Rotary Project**

Rotary is forging ahead with the project for Twin Rivers Park where all mini soccer is played. They have suggested building a concession and storage room which attaches to the existing washrooms. They are still waiting on funding from the federal government. If/when they receive the grant money, then they will talk to user groups about their plans. CMSA has money set aside for a project like this so we will patiently wait for them to advise CMSA.

**2) Coaching Update**

Scott Hutt, CMSA coach development, has offered to KSYSA that they join CMSA Soccerquest coaching clinics. This was respectfully declined. The KSYSA Learn to Train clinic from BC Soccer has been cancelled due to low enrollment.
